AUSLAN at Beverley DHS

Australian Sign Language (Auslan) is taught to all students at our school as part of our Languages Other Than English (LOTE) program - lead by the incredible Mrs Freeman.

Throughout the year, students participate in regular Auslan lessons, where they progressively build their skills and understanding. Younger students focus on learning foundational signs such as greetings, colours, numbers, family members, classroom routines and topic-based vocabulary. As students move through the school, they continue to revise commonly used signs while expanding their vocabulary and learning to use Auslan in simple, then more extended, conversations.

Auslan lessons support communication skills, cultural awareness and inclusion, providing students with a valuable learning experience.

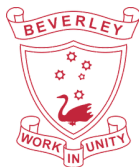
