BEVERLEY STUDENTS WIN INTERSCHOOL

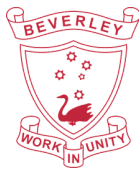

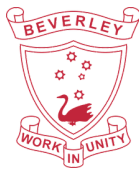
CADET CAMP
