Simply download the Qkr by Mastercard app and begin.

This App is available on your smart phone, tablet or computer. Once downloaded go to the search bar and enter Beverley School. Next select profile and create profiles for each of your children ensuring to include their year groups. Then return to the main menu.

From there ordering is quick and simple, you can order for each child individually. This also allows you to have ordering at your finger tips and enables payments with either credit or savings. Please make sure to select the correct order date!

Once you have finalised the orders they are sent straight through to ensure no order is missed. This saves money being lost on the way to school, looking for loose change and is a quick effective ordering process for busy parents.
