Principal's Update

Hello all,

As you may have heard last week, as of Monday the 8th of June parents and carers are once again welcome on school site to assist with the picking up and dropping off students. We are all very much looking forward to having such a huge part of our school community back on site albeit in a limited capacity. The ability for us to have parents on site for parent help, assemblies and carnivals is still prohibited at this point, though we look forward to that changing in the (hopefully near) future.

This Friday is our Faction Cross Country Carnival. Whilst due to COVID-19 related restrictions we are unable to run our normal course it is very exciting for the students and staff that the carnival is still taking place, even-though it is in an adapted format. Students will run the equivalent distance around the town oval, faction points and medals are both up for grabs. Unfortunately parents as much as your students and school staff would love to have you there to support them and create a great atmosphere no spectators are allowed to watch the event, as such the gates to the oval will be locked. Good luck to all students participating and thank you to Mrs Bailey for organising the event.

Thank you to all parents who have been keeping their children home when they have a temperature, are coughing, sneezing or have runny noses. All students who display symptoms of a cold or flu will be sent home from school or isolated in the sick bay until such time as they can be picked up by a parent or guardian. There is a bug going around town at the moment, please be vigilant and think of the wider community and keep your child home if they are sick or displaying symptoms.

As mentioned in Week 4's newsletter, due to COVID-19 there will be various changes to our normal reporting to parents communication this semester. Students will not receive A-E grades for subjects, they will receive a progress comment in English and Mathematics (Pre-Primary to Year 6) and English, HASS, Science and Mathematics (Years 7-10). All students will receive a personalised general comment and a generalised comment for all other curriculum areas. All students will be given feedback on their attitude, behaviour and effort (ABE) in all curriculum areas. Attendance will also not be reported on as the data is compromised with a large amount of the semester students either not being allowed to come to school, or being advised against it. If you have any questions regarding the reporting format, please send me an email and I would be more than happy to clarify.

Finally, Kindergarten enrolments for 2021 are now open, if your child turns 4 years old before the 30th of June 2021 please come into the school office and collect an enrolment form at your earliest convenience.

Additionally, we do have some old stock that we will be advertising at super cheap, discounted prices! Stay tuned for details- these will be offered on a first come, first served basis.

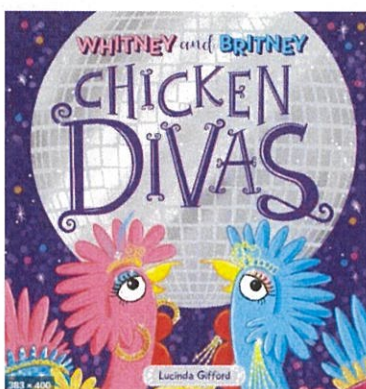
2020 Tea-Towel
