As a school we have contracted Compass Education to provide a suite of services with the hope that we will be rolling out the program at the commencement of Term 2. Regular updates and information will be shared as we transition to this new management system.


School Buses

Parents and students are responsible for the behaviour of students on school buses. If students continue to demonstrate negative behaviour or consistently misbehave they may be removed from the bus service indefinitely on advice from the Bus Contractor. Bus Drivers have a very difficult job to perform and they need to have all their attention on the road and traffic to ensure a safe journey for all. In addition, it seems that some school buses have been waiting at bus stops for students, as parents have not notified the Bus Driver that the student/s will not be

attending school. This causes unnecessary delays. Parents are responsible for informing the Bus Driver if they will not be on the school bus. If students are going to be absent from school, parents are required to make contact with their Bus Driver. If your child is not travelling home on the school bus in the afternoon, then contact also needs to be made with the Bus Driver. Additionally, if the student/s is not making use of the bus service on a regular basis then their entitlement will be treated as if they were a complimentary passenger.
