#### Hats - SunSmart

A general reminder to parents that the effects of regular exposure to the sun can cause significant skin damage if children are not taking the necessary steps to protect themselves by wearing appropriate clothing, including hats, and applying sunscreen when playing outside. As a school, we regularly supply and make available sunscreen to students to apply before going outside, and all students are expected to wear a hat (preferably broad-brimmed) when outside. There have been instances recently where some students have not had a hat at school and have had remain in undercover areas. Please make sure that your child/ren are bringing their hat to school with them each day.

#### Some Sun Smart facts:

- School hours fall within peak UV periods of the day.
- Exposure to UV in adolescence contributes to skin cancer risk in later life.
- Melanoma is the most common cancer in Australian adolescents aged 15–29 years.


## **Uniform Shop News:**

- Scroll down and click on "Schools"
- Choose "BDHS"
- Once you have selected your items and finished shopping, hit the cart icon and then create your account- this is where you enter your payment details.
- Once parents have created their own accounts they can shop as often as they like providing they remember their username and password.



## Dental Van Visit - Term 4

It's that time of year again when the dental van is coming to visit Beverley D.H.S; we will be starting on **Monday 12**<sup>th</sup> **October**.

If your child is enrolled in the service you can expect (or may even have received) an appointment letter, we do endeavour to book siblings in at the same time but occasionally siblings are separated, if you have received multiple appointments and would like them together please call the staff at the dental van and we will make every effort to accommodate this.

We do encourage parents to attend the first appointment as even if the child has previously been seen in our service we still require medical history's to be either updated or a new history taken, and other paperwork completed, as well as if your child requires treatment its often easier to discuss in person and to gain written consent.

If you are unable to attend the first appointment please call the dental van staff (Mohamed and Rachel, Ph: 0437 202 882) before the appointment and advise us that you wish for us to get your child from class (in this case we will send paperwork home with your child, so please check their backpack :o) )

We are expecting to be at the school for approximately 6 weeks so please return all paperwork ASAP either by dropping in to the van or alternatively it can be given to your child's teacher.

Due to Covid-19 there has been a few small changes in the way we deliver our service, we do prefer to keep the number of people in the van at any one time to a minimum where possible, occasionally if we have large families in we may ask some children to wait outside the van (as long as they are old enough to do so). Also we do ask everyone who enters the van to sanitise their hands with the provided hand sanitiser.

You will also receive a letter "Before attending your next dental appointment", the purpose of this is to screen all patients/parents/carers for Covid-19 prior to attending the dental van. As stated if anyone attending this appointment answers "YES" to any of the questions please call the staff BEFORE attending the appointment (Ph.: 0437 202 882).

Finally we are looking forward to seeing you all and visiting the lovely town of Beverley for the beginning of term 4.
