In Memoriam - Vale Margaret Barrett-Lennard It was with great sadness that last week we informed the school community of the passing of one of our teachers, Mrs. Margaret Barrett-Lennard. Regularly known as and referred to as 'Marg' by staff across the school, she was a long-serving staff member at Beverley DHS, and will be fondly remembered for her selfless commitment, devotion and enthusiasm for providing her students with a quality education in her classroom. She possessed a very dry sense of humour, a sharp wit and positive demeanour, and was often one of the first people on hand if you needed help



or support. Marg's legacy will be enduring for years to come, and for many of our students, while not realised yet, her positive impact on their education will remain with them as they move forward into the wider global community. As a staff we have been reminiscing with much laughter, camaraderie and deep admiration and respect, along with a mixture of sadness, grief and mourning, as we recollect the many 'Margisms' that perpetuated our working day at school. Once again, we would like to extend our sincere condolences to the Barrett-Lennard family and our thoughts are with them at this time. P&C Donation - Red Shed Artificial Turf Installation Earlier this year the P&C approved \$16,000.00 in funds to be allocated towards the installation of artificial turf outside the Red Shed to create another undercover learning place for Physical Education lessons. The installation is nearly completed with just some bordering and earthworks to be finalised. It should be fully finished by the start of September. This area will allow for PE lessons to occur and continue uninterrupted in extreme weather conditions or for other school, classroom and student-based



activities that need an undercover space. This new addition to the school will also provide another shaded play space for recess and lunch. Once again I would like to acknowledge and thank our hard-working P&C Committee, members, and our parents and community members, who continue to support our school through their fundraising efforts.
