School Board Update

Summary of Board Meeting 4th September

- After our meeting with Student Leaders in Term 3 the Board had a review of the answers provided by students. The request for a D & T (manual arts) option was highlighted. We are exploring options, as the position is proving difficult to fill.
- The review of financials show the water bills are high for winter period. The school is conducting a meter audit to check for water leaks.
- As we are ending our 3 year cycle, it's now time to develop a new Business Plan for the school. The school staff developed a template which all board members reviewed. Over the next 5 months a new Business Plan with input from parents, staff and board members will be created. **Stay tuned for the parent forum.**
- Staff movements was the last agenda item. Wendy Moore has taken a 6 month Principal position at Nannup DHS and the Board wished Wendy well for this position. The Board was advised by the District Manager that an applicant had been chosen to fill our Principal position.

Choir News


Choir at the Beverley Show


CRC Science Excursion
