Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Beverley District High School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges relevant to secondary students for 2024. The total amount of Contributions that parents/guardians are asked to pay has been contained to the \$235.00 as set by the Department of Education.

#### **CONTRIBUTIONS:**

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure and help us to deliver a variety of learning programs for our secondary students.

Payment of Contributions may be made in full at the start of the year or alternatively a payment plan can be arranged with the Manager Corporate Services. **Holders of Pension, Health Care or Concession Cards are eligible for \$235.00 towards the education program charges.**

Any residual will be applied to the voluntary contribution. Application for Secondary Assistance close 28 March 2024.
