The Beverley District High School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges relevant to secondary students for 2025. The total amount of Contributions that parents/guardians are asked to pay has been contained to the \$235.00 as set by the Department of Education.

#### **CONTRIBUTIONS:**

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure and help us to deliver a variety of learning programs for our secondary students.

Payment of Contributions may be made in full at the start of the year or alternatively a payment plan can be arranged with the Manager Corporate Services. Holders of Pension, Health Care or Concession Cards are eligible for \$235.00 towards the education program charges.

Any residual will be applied to the voluntary contribution. Application for Secondary Assistance close 11 April 2025.
