Classes for 2019

In 2019, classes will continue to work closely together to maximise learning, planning and continuity. While sometimes enrolments and staff movements may result in last minute changes, the school's current planning is as follows:

- **Kindergarten and Pre-Primary:** Classes will work and play together at least once each week. For Semester 1, the teachers will be Mrs Angela Sims (Kindy) and Mrs Sally Kilpatrick (Pre-Primary). In Semester 2, Mrs Hawke will be back from long service leave, and will be in Pre-Primary along with Mrs Kilpatrick.
- **Year 1 and 2 classes** will be working together on most afternoons and for some morning sessions throughout the week. The teachers will be Mrs Corinna Thomas (Year 1) and Mrs Samantha Gollan (Year 2).
- The **Year 3/4 class** teacher will be Ms Jennifer McCarthy. Mrs Kellie Shaw and Mrs Thomas will also work in the Year 3/4 class at different times during the week.
- The **Year 5/6 class** teachers will be Mrs Margaret Barrett-Lennard and Mrs Sarah Aynsley. Mrs Shaw and Mrs Alisha Murray will also take groups for Maths and English lessons each day.
- The **secondary** form teachers will be Mrs Shirley Wallis (Year 7/8) and Mrs Sharyn Morrell (Year 9/10). Mrs Wallis will teach English, HASS and Art and Mrs Morrell will teach Science, Mathematics and Digital Technologies.
